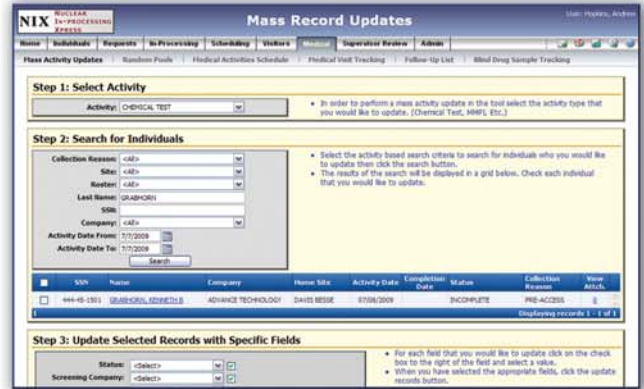


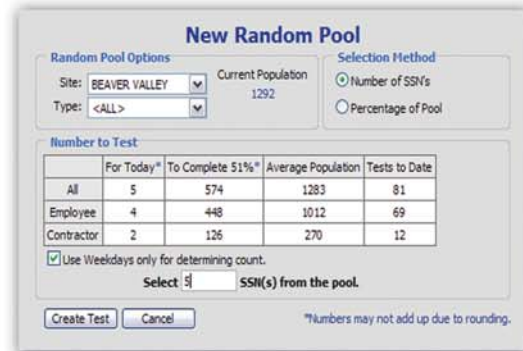
SCHEDULING & MASS UPDATES

Nuclear In-Processing Xpress (NIX) includes a section to help facilitate the Fitness for Duty activities that are required for in-processing as well as medical activities important to retaining UA/UAA. Medical personnel are given the ability to input activities one at a time or using a mass activity update grid where they are given the ability to update and complete a batch of activities at a time.



RANDOM DRUG & ALCOHOL SCREENING

The medical section allows for the creation of random drug and alcohol test pools based on a percentage of all employees/contractors eligible. Statistics are provided to show what percent of all employees or contractors have been pulled for random tests in a given year. All activities can be scheduled using the Medical Activities Schedule that is provided in the application.



BLIND DRUG SAMPLE TRACKING

The medical section of NIX also handles the tracking of individuals in the follow-up program on-site with interfaces to the Personnel Access Data System (PADS) to upload and download test results. NIX can be used to track blind drug samples and maintain results, as well as, other statistics.
